



### Temporary Barn Use Guidelines Update as of September 1, 2021

In order to protect our community while we are continuing to experience challenges with CV 19 the following use guidelines have been put in place for the reopening of our building as of September 1, 2021. - The use of Brigham Hill Community Barn will temporarily be restricted to groups of 20 or less until further notice.
- Users are expected to ensure that unvaccinated individuals utilize the proper face covering at all times while in the building.
- Users are expected to ensure all table, counter and restroom surfaces are wiped clean after the group has completed their visit and prior to departure. Sanitizing spray and paper towels are available on the kitchen pass through as you enter the great room to your left.
- Users recognize that the deck area is off limits and the doors to the deck are only to be utilized during an emergency exit of the building.
- All food served on the property must be prepared in a local health department licensed and ServSafe certified kitchen. No home prepared baked goods or potluck meals are allowed.
- Prepared trays/sandwiches/baked goods from local supermarkets such as [Wegmans](#) or [Stop and Shop](#), sandwich shops such as [Pepperoni Express](#) or [Bushel and Peck](#) and caterers such as [Peppers](#), [Buggy Whip](#) and [Wegmans](#) are all good choices for use in providing food for your event/meeting.
